Day 1: Thursday, July 1, 2027 Overnight Flight You're on your way to Iceland, a land forged by fire and ice, where adventurous landscapes give way to a rich cultural heritage. Prepare to discover the dramatic contrasts from ethereal lava fields and thundering waterfalls to charming coastal villages.

Day 2: Friday, July 2, 2027 Arrive Reykjavík, Iceland Enjoy time to get to know the place where your journey begins.

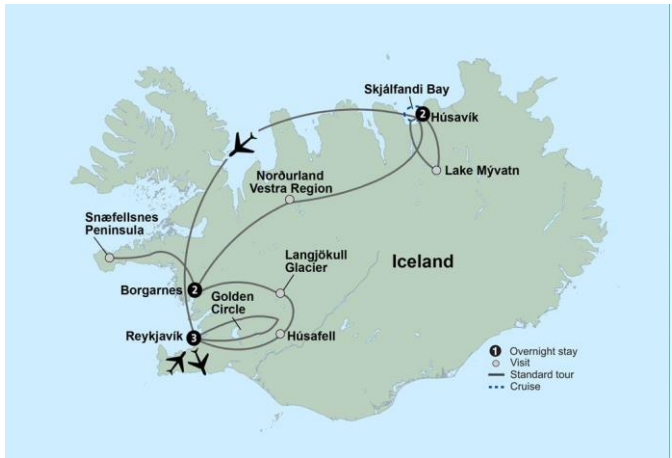
Day 3: Saturday, July 3, 2027 Reykjavík Your tour opens today in Reykjavík, Iceland's vibrant capital. Explore the city's old core on a guided walking tour featuring the Parliament, harbor, city hall, and the city's oldest building. Marvel at the dazzling glass façade of the Harpa Concert Hall, a true marvel of modern architecture. This evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner featuring fresh Icelandic ingredients at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 4: Sunday, July 4, 2027 Reykjavík - Golden Circle - Reykjavík Travel the Golden Circle to see Iceland's most iconic natural wonders, including the Mid-Atlantic Ridge in Thingvellir National Park, where you can walk between two continents. Visit a geothermal bakery to see how Icelanders use natural steam to cook food underground, and taste the delicious, slow-cooked "lava bread." Continue along the Golden Circle and take in the beauty of the Gullfoss (Golden Falls) double-cascade waterfall before visiting the explosive Strokkur fountain geyser. Return to Reykjavík for an evening at leisure. (B)

Day 5: Monday, July 5, 2027 Reykjavík - Húsafell - Langjökull Glacier - Borgarnes This morning, travel inland to Húsafell to view its misty waterfalls cascading over ancient lava rocks. Experience an **Impact Moment** during a visit to an Icelandic goat farm, where you'll learn how local farmer Jóhanna helped revive this historic breed, dating back to Iceland's earliest settlers. Enjoy a simple meal of homemade specialties before continuing onward. Then, bundle up for an adventurous ascent of Langjökull glacier* via mountain truck. Go "Into the Glacier" to explore the shimmering blue ice inside the world's largest man-made ice tunnel.** End the day in Borgarnes, your home for the next 2 nights. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, July 6, 2027 Borgarnes - Snæfellsnes Peninsula - Borgarnes Journey to the stunning Snæfellsnes Peninsula with its camera-ready black sand beaches, mountain peaks, volcanic craters, rocky coastlines, and tiny fishing villages. Enjoy free time for lunch in Arnarstapi, a beautiful, small fishing village at the foot of Mt. Stapafell, framed by columnar basalt and striking sea cliffs. In the afternoon, take in views on Mount Kirkjufell, with its iconic shape and freestanding form — this is one of the most photographed landscapes in Iceland. (B, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, July 7, 2027 Borgarnes - Norðurland Vestra region - Húsavík Today, head to the scenic Norðurland Vestra region, celebrated for its horse-breeding heritage. Visit a family-owned farm, grab your camera for a photo tour of the stables and

interact with these friendly animals and their caretakers. En route, stop at one of Iceland's most historic waterfalls, Goðafoss, where legend says Iceland converted to Christianity in AD 1000. End your day in Húsavík, one of the first settlements on the island. (B, D)

Day 8: Thursday, July 8, 2027 Húsavík - Lake Mývatn - Húsavík - Whale Watching This morning, take in the otherworldly landscapes surrounding Lake Mývatn, including the Hverir geothermal area, where bubbling mud pools resemble Martian terrain. Join your Tour Manager for a hike through Dimmuborgir, where fantastical lava formations and mystical caves inspire Icelandic legends. After free time for lunch, gear up in thermal wear to join expert whale watchers on a cruise on Skjálfandi Bay. Aboard RIB Zodiacs, get as close as you can to whales in northern Iceland. You may see humpback, minke, fin, or harbor porpoise, and possibly the orca or giant blue whales that frequent these waters. (B)

Day 9: Friday, July 9, 2027 Húsavík - Akureyri - Reykjavík This morning, fly*** back to Reykjavík. Then, **it's your choice!** Experience the Icelandic tradition of geothermal bathing with a dip in the warm, mineral-rich waters of scenic Sky Lagoon**** **-OR-** take a thrilling virtual experience ride, giving you the feeling of flying over Iceland's glaciers, fjords, and most iconic landscapes. Gather this evening for a farewell dinner at a restaurant highlighting Icelandic cuisine. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, July 10, 2027 Reykjavík - Tour Ends Head home having uncovered Iceland's adventurous side. (B)

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 4. This means you're ready to seize the day, whatever it may bring. You lead an active life at home (walking, biking, and half or full day hikes are things you may enjoy) and 10,000 steps a day is normal for you. You can handle longer walking tours (more than 3 hours covering 3+ miles at a steady clip) and activities that involve traversing uneven terrain, steep slopes, standing for periods of time, and varying altitudes and temperatures. You don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late nights, and full days. You can handle altitudes of 9,000 feet or higher with little to no issue. This level is not appropriate for travelers who use wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 16 people (maximum of 24).

****Children under the age of 12 are not permitted at Sky Lagoon. At FlyOver Iceland, experience participants must be at least 40 inches (101 centimeters) tall. Children (12 and under) must be accompanied by an adult or guardian (14 years or older).

Boarding/disembarking the RIB Zodiac boats requires balance and mobility. You'll need to step into a small boat from the dock and maintain stability onboard. The ride may be bumpy, with spray and motion from wind and waves. Being comfortable with motion and sea conditions helps ensure enjoyment of the experience.

The ice tunnel experience requires walking on uneven and icy terrain at the glacier site.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Summer temperatures in Iceland are cool and variable, typically ranging from 4°C to low 15°C (mid-40s to the low-60s°F). Weather can change quickly — sunshine, wind, and rain may all occur on the same day. Expect strong coastal winds and cooler conditions near waterfalls, glaciers, and the ocean. Daylight hours are very long (up to 20+ hours), which can affect sleep; eye masks are recommended. Weather conditions on the water are colder and windier than on land.

Most natural sites, such as waterfalls, beaches, glaciers, and lava fields, require walking on unpaved, uneven surfaces rendered slippery by ice and rain. Sturdy footwear and waterproof jackets are required if you plan to walk in these areas or approach the waterfalls. Your safety is our priority. Please always stay on marked paths and follow the Tour Manager's instructions.

This is a physically active tour with a brisk pace. You should be prepared for full days with significant walking and standing on uneven natural terrain.

We seek to best utilize your time while on tour; to account for the potential of adverse weather, some activities or days may need to be altered, shifted, or cancelled.

***Morning departure times may vary depending on the internal flight schedules.

**The "Into the Glacier" visit is not exclusive to Collette, and you may share the experience with other travelers.

On occasion, some activities may not be available due to inclement weather.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by the observance of religious/local holidays or seasonal closures.

*The Langjökull Glacier Experience is weather permitting. Cold-weather clothing is required to join these activities.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Smaller coaches, which may not be lavatory-equipped, may be used on this tour. In this case, frequent stops are made during travel periods.

Due to flight schedules, a pre or post night may be required in some Icelandair gateway cities (at an additional cost). Please inquire at time of reservation.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to tour scheduling, arrival flights should arrive prior to 10:00 a.m.

An internal flight is required in order to participate on this tour and is included in the final price, quoted at time of booking.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.
