Day 1, April 22

Depart USA on an overnight flight from home city to Paris.

Day 2, April 23, ARRIVE IN PARIS

Arrive Paris. Transfer to hotel. Remainder of the day on your own.

Day 3, April 24, PARIS

Free day to explore Paris on your own. (B)

Day 4, April 25, PARIS

Free day to explore Paris on your own. At 5pm, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a welcome drink. (B)

Day 5, April 26, PARIS

Free time this morning followed by guided sightseeing that features Arc de Triomphe, les Champs-Elysées and a visit to the Courtyard of Les Invalides (B, D)

Day 6, April 27, PARIS-GIVERNY-ROUEN-DEAUVILLE

Wander through the gardens which inspired Monet to create some of his most celebrated Impressionist paintings at his home in Giverny. Enjoy a walking tour of Rouen and free time at Promenade des Planches. (B)

Day 7, April 28, DEAUVILLE-EXCURSION TO NORMANDY BEACHES

Walk in the footsteps of heroes on the beaches of Normandy, where Allied Forces stormed the beach with courage and heroism in World War II.

Visit Pointe du Hoc, Omaha Beach, and the American Cemetery with the Monument to the Brave. See the Mulberry Harbor remains at Arromanches and the Canada House at Juno Beach. (B,D)

Day 8. April 29, DEAUVILLE-MONT ST. MICHEL

Guided sightseeing at the magical Mont St. Michel Abbey which sits on top of a tidal island on the coast of Normandy. Learn how this strategic position has protected it from being invaded but also has made it the ideal location for a place of confinement. (B,D)

Day 9, April 30, MONT ST. MICHEL-ANGERS-LOIRE VALLEY

See the medieval castle and take a scenic drive en route to the Loire Valley. (B)

Day 10, May 1, LOIRE VALLEY. EXCURSION TO CHÂTEAUX COUNTRY

Visit Chambord and Chenonceau Castles followed by a wine tasting. Sip the very best in French wine in the picturesque French countryside along the Loire River Valley, where many stately castles dot the landscape. (B,D)

Day 11, May 2, LOIRE VALLEY-PARIS

Explore Paris with free time this afternoon. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner cruise on the Seine with incredible sights of the city. (B,D)

Day 12, May 3, PARIS

Safe travels until we meet again! Your vacation ends with breakfast this morning. (B)
