Hear fascinating stories of legends and folklore that bring this remarkable region to life and enjoy authentic Navajo fry bread in the ancient tradition.

DAY 5 LAKE POWELL

Wonders of Wind & Water This morning, explore Antelope Slot Canyon with a local Navajo guide. Be mesmerized by an amazing fantasy world of stone, created by wind and water. DAY 6 LAKE POWELL-BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK, UTAH
